

**OFFICIAL SUMMARY PROCEEDINGS OF THE BOARD OF  
COUNTY COMMISSIONERS, TETON COUNTY, WYOMING**

The Teton County Board of Commissioners met in regular meeting on **May 16, 2022** in the Commissioners Chambers located at 200 S. Willow in Jackson. The meeting was called to order at 9:03 a.m.

Commission present: Luther Propst, Vice-Chairman, Mark Barron, Mark Newcomb and Greg Epstein were present. Natalia Macker, Chairwoman, was absent.

**ADOPT AGENDA**

A motion was made by Commissioner Barron and seconded by Commissioner Epstein to adopt the agenda as presented. Vice-Chairman Propst called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

**PUBLIC COMMENT**

Public comment was given by Melissa Turley regarding a budget amendment request for START Bus to allow evening service before July.

Public comment was given by Bruce Abel, Interim START Director regarding the START Budget request.

**ACTION ITEMS**

A motion was made by Commissioner Newcomb and seconded by Commissioner Barron to approve the May 16, 2022 county voucher run in the amount of \$720,093.04. Vice-Chairman Propst called for a vote. The vote showed all in favor and the motion carried.

**A. 9:30am Budget Workshop**

**B. 9:45 AM – Wyoming Gaming Commission Workshop**

307 Horse Racing currently holds a license to run wagering at pari-mutuel events in Wyoming and is looking to establish an outlet in Teton County. Approval by the Teton County Commissioners would allow 307 Horse Racing to apply for a permit from the Wyoming Gaming Commission to operate at a specific location in Teton County.

Keith Gingery, Chief Deputy County Attorney, and Charles Moore, Wyoming Gaming Commission Executive Director, informed the Board of Wyoming statutory requirements for gaming.

Kyle Ridgeway, 307 Horse Racing Chief Operating Officer, and Jack Greer, Co-Founder of 307 Horse Racing, commented on the application.

A resolution to allow the Applicant to apply to be a permittee will come before the Board at a future Board of County Commissioners regular meeting.

The meeting recessed at 10:17 a.m. and reconvened at 10:28 a.m.

**BUDGET WORKSHOP – CONTINUED**

The Board continued discussions of the fiscal year 2023 budget, including discussions concerning Human Service and Community Development agency requests, FTE requests, and capital requests.
