



Revocation of Teton Health District Recommendations #4 and #6

As the Teton Health District Officer, I have issued 7 different non-enforcable recommendations in Teton County. Recommendations 1, 2, 3, and 4 were issued on March 24, 2020. Recommendations 5 and 6 were issued on March 29, 2020. Recommendation #7 was issued on April 6, 2020. Prior to todays' date, I had already revoked Recommendations 1, 2, 3, and 5. On today's date, I am revoking Recommendations #4 and #6.

Recommendation #4 was a recommendation regarding visitors and non-resident homeowners. Recommendation #6 was a recommendation regarding residents leaving the State of Wyoming and two counties in Idaho. Based on positive metrics and data currently being received for Teton County, Wyoming, I have decided to revoke Recommendations #4 and #6.

The only remaining recommendation is Recommendation #7 which is stated below:

Recommendation #7

All people in Teton County should wear cloth face coverings in public settings where other physical distancing measures may be difficult to maintain (e.g. grocery stores, pharmacies, crowded outdoor spaces such as sidewalks and workplaces).
